HOW TO APPLY FOR A TRADE TASTER PROGRAM

- Firstly, you will need to head over to <u>www.tafeapply.com</u> and enter the application code TQEC23TT2 to get your application started. Applications open on Wednesday 15 March 2023 at 9am, so the code will not work before that time. NOTE: You will need to have your USI (mandatory) and LUI (if you have one) details handy for your application.
- 2. In the first screen you will need to select your school (from the drop down options) and your enter in your personal details.
- 3. When you get down to the TAFE Schools Program selection leave the blue button on 'Search by Industry'.
- 4. To select an industry area, click on the drop down options and select 'Taster Program'.
- 5. To select a Schools Program/Course, click on the drop down option to to select the relevant

Trade Taster Program you are interested in.

Your Program options will include the following.

Program name	Details
Year 10 Trade Taster Program	Select this option if you are interested in testing out a few different trade areas including; construction, furnishing and engineering.
Year 10 Skills Taster Program – Cookery	Select this option if you are interested in learning more about working in a kitchen or cookery environment.
Year 10 Skills Taster Program – Salon Assistant	Select this option if you are interested in learning more about working in a hairdressing salon.
Year 10 Skills Taster Program – Community Services (ECEC)	Select this option if you are interested in working in early childhood or community services industries.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What happens after I submit my application?

Your application will need to be approved by your parent/guardian and your school. Once your application has been approved, TAFE Queensland will contact you by email to advise you on the outcome of your application and further information.

What happens if I don't get a place?

As there are limited places available we highly suggest that you apply for a place on **Wednesday 15 March 2023 at 9.00am (AEST)** so you don't miss out. We offer places on a first-come-first-serve basis. Students who miss out will be notified they are on a waitlist and contacted if a place becomes available.

Fees and eligibility

This is a fully subsided program so there is no cost to eligible Year 10 students.

To be eligible to study this program;

- you must be a current Year 10 student (studying both maths and english)
- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen
- or hold a qualifying Visa (please contact the TAFE at School team (on our email below) for more information on Visa's).

Students studying the TAFE at School Program must not be currently enrolled into a VETiS funded course/ certificate at the same time. You can speak with your school or VET Coordinator if you are unsure about this and what a VETiS funded course is.
